

SILER CACTUS RELOCATION LABORER

Position Announcement (OPEN)

JOB SUMMARY:

The Siler Cactus is listed as a federally threatened species. This position, under the direction of the Environmental/Special Projects Director, is responsible for locating and extracting this cactus from the Lake Powell Pipeline corridor and then replanting them in a new site.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Properly identify Siler Pincushion Cactus within a 250-foot-wide corridor paralleling SR 389
- Map and document found cacti
- Identify the cacti that is to be relocated and using proper procedures handle and relocate to designated area
- Work outdoors using shovels and other hand tools.
- Have the ability to work in extreme weather conditions in the outdoors and know proper care for long exposure to prevent injury.
- When trained, must be able to work with limited or no direct supervision.
- Must be able to follow directions closely and possess knowledge of proper use of safety equipment.
- Be able to interact well with other staff members. Strict confidentiality is required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be able to spend hours at a time on your feet walking in the elements during the summer months
- Ability to perform physical labor on a continuous basis is required
- Be dependable, hardworking, honest, and possess a positive work attitude
- Be a quick learner and a self-starter
- Must be able to bend and lift up to 50 lbs. and work outdoors for long periods of time
- Must have valid driver's license
- Must possess a high school diploma or GED
- Pass a fingerprint/background check required
