## DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Must have experience and demonstrate supervisory or lead person experience working with a crew of adult men/women of diverse backgrounds and be able to interact well with other staff members.
- Must have verifiable sawyer experience and the ability to use hand saws and other hand tools.
- Have the ability to work in extreme weather conditions in the outdoors and know proper care for long exposure to prevent injury.
- Must be able to work with limited or no direct supervision.
- Must be able to follow directions closely and possess knowledge of proper use of safety equipment.
- Use of a chipper machine is recommended but not required. Mechanical aptitude is a plus.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must provide documentation of sawyer experience or certification(s)
- Be dependable, hardworking, honest, and possess a positive work attitude
- Must be able to bend and lift up to 100 lbs and work outdoors for long periods of time
- Must have valid driver's license and verifiable clean driving record
- Pass a fingerprint/background check required
- Must possess a high school diploma or GED
